

At y<sup>e</sup> Request of Thomas Lloyd and Comp<sup>ts</sup> that we would grant them one hundred acres of Land in y<sup>e</sup> Libertys of Philadelphia on y<sup>e</sup> west side of Schuylkill (which was formerly granted y<sup>e</sup> by y<sup>e</sup> Proprietary and Govern<sup>ts</sup>) Proportionable to their Purchass of ffive ~~thousand~~ Thousand acres, which was according to y<sup>e</sup> Proprietaries ord<sup>rs</sup> in part Laid out, And whereas we are given to understand by y<sup>e</sup> Dep<sup>ty</sup> Survey<sup>r</sup> that there is about Twenty acres of ffast Land Left adjoining to y<sup>e</sup> aforesaid one hundred acres and y<sup>e</sup> Marsh swamp and Cripple Lying before y<sup>e</sup> said Tracts, untaken up which said 20 acres of ffast Land Swamp and Cripple is Requested by y<sup>e</sup> said Thomas Lloyd to take up y<sup>e</sup> same to his owne use

These are therefore in y<sup>e</sup> Proprietaries name to will and Require thee fforthwith to survey or cause to be surveyd unto y<sup>e</sup> said Thomas Lloyd and Comp<sup>ts</sup> y<sup>e</sup> aforesaid one hundred acres, and unto y<sup>e</sup> said Thomas Lloyd y<sup>e</sup> aforesaid twenty acres of ffast Land woses North East bounds thereof to be on Bever Creek or Runn and the marsh aforesaid And make Returns thereof into y<sup>e</sup> Secretaries office, dated at Philadelphia the 23<sup>d</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> 2<sup>d</sup> mo. 1692
