Benjamin Lightfoot (by John Starr) sent a Draught to the Surveyor Generals Office Containing about 434<sup>sq</sup>. Surveyed the 24<sup>th</sup> 3<sup>d</sup> M<sup>o</sup> 1762 in pursuance of a Warr.<sup>t</sup> granted to Stamper, Elias & John Bland dated the 29<sup>th</sup> of May 1742 for 600<sup>ac</sup> which appears to <sup>be</sup> the same land surveyed for the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Proprietaries the 9<sup>th</sup> of December 1734 by Nicholas Scull which was Leased to Peter Rambo and ~~Thomas~~ <sup>Benja</sup> Fairman - which survey the Surveyor General rejected and sent back to said Lightfoot
