Seal. Upon an agreement made with Our Brother Thomas Freame for the Quantity of Two Thousand Seven hundred and Eighty Acres of Land lying near Our Mannor of Perkasy in the County of Bucks. These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be Surveyed unto Our said Brother Thomas Freame at the place aforesaid the said Quantity of Two Thousand Seven ~~hundred~~ ^{hundred and} eighty Acres of Land and make return thereof into Our Secretarys Office in order for Confirmation and for which this shall be thy Sufficient Warrant. Given under Our Hands and the Lesser Seal of Our Province at Philadelp.^a This 10th day of May 1735.
