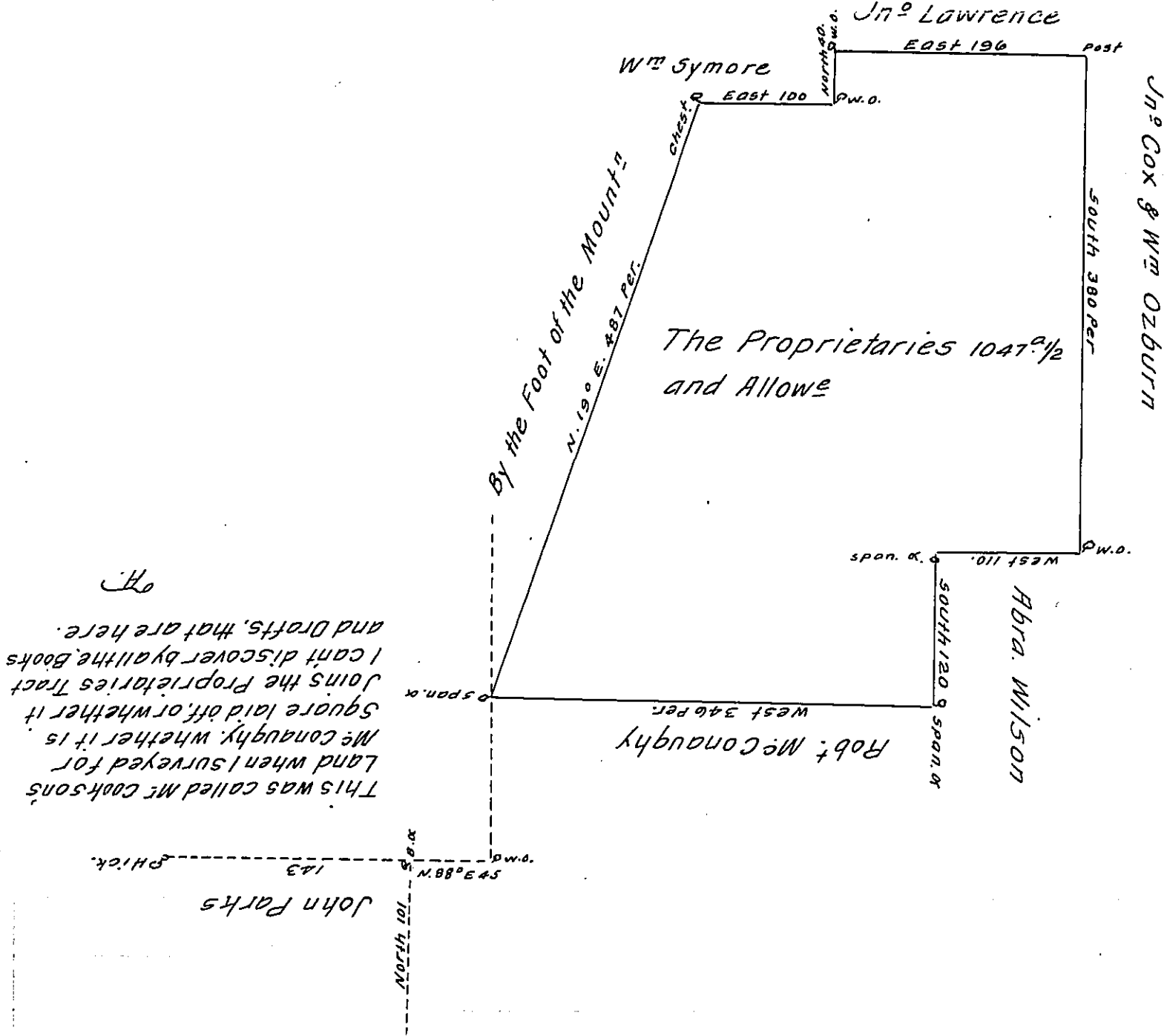


P.S. This not sent as a Draft to be Received in the office, but only to discover the right by which the same was laid out & held.
