The above is in Tenure of Christian Puss. to whom the same is now intended to be Conveyed. Containing One hundred and Twenty five Acres and 53 Perches of Land together with the usual Allowance at Six per Cent for Roads. Now Resurveyed for the Said Christian Puss. By Order of Richard Hockley Esquire on the 8th November. Anno - 1769.
