

Philadelphia, April 11th 1772.

George Vogel and Christian Vogel desire to purchase from the Honourable the Proprietaries 250 Acres. Part of the Manor of Springetsbury in York County, adjoining Lands Possessed by Jacob Sheffer, Philip Wintermaker, Henry Summer and Michael Ulrich. But as I cannot agree with them before a proper Survey is made of the Premisses. You are therefore desired forthwith to Survey or cause to be Surveyed (at the Expence of the said Geo. and Christⁿ Vogel) the sd Tract of 250 A^s of Land and to furnish me with a Draught. Let it be certified by the Deputy Surveyor what Distance the sd Land is from the Town of York and of what Quality the Land is.
