I hereby certify into his office that I have resurveyed and layd out unto Letitia Penn the aforesaid lott with the vacancy and find it on the front street or Delaware 172 feet, on the high Street 402. at the west end bounded w<sup>t</sup> the second Street 172: on the south bounded w<sup>t</sup> John Genets Lotts 402 the Contaim<sup>t</sup> of which is 69144 feet, I say Layd out by me for the aforesaid Letitia Penns the 12<sup>th</sup> day of the 1<sup>st</sup> month 170/1.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twenty-second day of April 1910.
