



Pursuant to an order from the Proprietors Com^{rs} of Prop^{ty} and a Warr from the Governor bearing date ye 31 of ye 8th 1701 directed unto Edward Pennington then Survey^r Generall since deceased I do hereby Certiey that I have surveyd and laid outth the 13th of ye 2^d mo. ensueing a certain lot of ground in Philadelphia bounded by a line deviding it from David Giffins lot north 18 degrees east 306 feet and one the north with bak lots west 18 degrees north 132 feet and one the west by the first Street from Delaware south 18 degrees west 306 feet and one the south with the High Street east 18 degrees south: and is according to the bounds above described returnid into the Generall survey^r Office the day above.
