



Land in the Tenure of James Hammer Situate in New Providence in the County of Philad- elphia in the Province of Pennsylvania Begins at a Black oak standing by land in the Tenure of Robert Megummary thence south west by the land of Adam Hammer Junr one hundred and thirty four perches to a post thence south east by the land of Adam Hammer late of the same place ninety two perches to a post thence north forty two degrees & 1/2 east by the land of John Jacobs one hundred and thirty four perches to a white oak tree thence north west by land in the Tenure of Phillip Frank and Robert Megummary ninety three perches to the place of Beginning containing seventy seven acres and seventy five perches Surveyd April Anno Domini 1749.
