Sometime in November 1776 Charles McClure applied to the Proprietaries for a Lott of Ground joining the Town of Carlisle on the southeast corner of the same, lying between Pomphret Street, South Street East Street and the Letort Spring, and hath now renewed his application to having the same done, which I desire you will survey (Leaving an ally to extend to the water, agreeable to the plan of the Town) the aforesaid mentioned ground and make return of the same to me.
