

A piece of a ground laid out on the 20th of September 1738 for a burying ground for — Levi a Jew sit on the north side of Spruce Street between the 8th & 9th St^s 60ft front, the east side thereof being 240 ft West from the West side of 8th St^s laid out by advice of Clem^t Plumsted the Proprietor being out of Town.
