At the Request of Joshua Hart and Alice his Wife of Torrcester in y^e County of Northton in Great Britain (the said Alice being only Daughter and Heiress of John King late of Hadbury in the County of Bucks in Great Britain Deceased) by their Attorney Rich^d Robinson of Philadelphia that We would Grant them to take up one Thousand Acres of Land in this Province being the Original Purchase of the said John King from the Propriet^r by Indenture of Lease & release bearing date the 2^d & 3^d days of December Anno Dⁿⁱ 1681 These are to authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be Surveyed unto the said Joshua Hart and Alice his Wife within the said Province According to the Method of Townships appointed the said quantity of one Thousand Acres of Land that has not been already Surveyed nor appropriated nor is Seated by the Indians and make Return thereof into y^e Secretarys Office in Order to a further Confirmation Given under our hands & Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 23^d 2^d Month Anno Dⁿⁱ 1716
