

Surveyd and Laid out to Samuel Hudson this 23^d Day of April 1720 a Certain
piece of Land in Myomensing in the County of Philad^e by him bought of Benjamin
Bartkson who was Present at the Survey Beginning at Post by the Road from
Philad^e to Passyunk at a Corner of Moses Cox's Land Thence running South
forty Seven Degr^s West by the said Road twenty eight Perches and a half to a
Post Then North thirty degrees West by Andrew Wheelers Land Seventy eight
Perches and a half to a Small Medlar tree Then North East twenty eight Perches
and a half to a Black Oak Then by the lands of Geo. Emlitt & Moses Cox South
thirty One degr^s East Eighty Perches & a half to the Beginning.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in
the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made
conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of
February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused
the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg,
