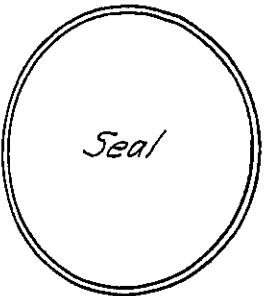

 At the Request of ~~Thomas Penn of Philadelphia~~ That I would grant him a Resurvey on a Tract of Land Situate in Dublin Township in the County of Philadelphia adjoining to the Lands of George Smedley and Robert Whetton laid out the 30th of the 12th Moth 1687 by Virtue of ~~the Proprietaries~~ ^{my} Warr^t bearing date the 29th of the 2^d Moth 1683 for three hundred Acres to ^{his Father} Rich^d Hilliard deceased ~~in whole Right the said T. Penn claims by Marriage of Mary the Hilliards Widow~~. These are to require thee forthwith to Resurvey or cause to be resurvey'd unto him ~~at Penn~~ ^{Hilliard} the said Tract of Land according to the true Lines of the former Survey And make Returns thereof into my Secretaries Office Given under my Hand and Seal at Philadelphia the 16th day of the 10th Moth 1700
