



By Vertue of a War^t from Edward Perrington Survey^r Genera^l Directed unto me bearing date the 27th day of the 12th m^o 170⁹ I heare by Certiefy into his office that I have Rea^v Surveyd and Laid out unto Josiah Ellis Son of Josiah Ellis first Purches^r a Certaine tract of Land on^e the west sid^e of Poquesin Creeke in the County of Philadelphia beginneing at a stak^e set in the Ground ~~in~~ Neere a whit^e oke in the Line of William Hils Land from thenc^e South East by an old Line of Marked trees 860 perches to a stak^e sett in the ground by the said Creek from thenc^e by the Sevrall Courses of the same 144 prches to a tree marked ~~tree~~ by the Creek sid^e from thenc^e North West by an old Line of marked trees 784 prches to a Stak^e Sett in the ground by a ~~the~~ Roade Leading by the said Hils Line from thenc^e North East 109 prches by an old Line of marked trees to the place of beginneing Containeing and Laid out for five hundred & ~~sixty~~ ^{seventy} accrs of Land the 27th of the 1st m^o 1707 . . .
