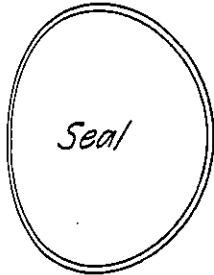

*At the Request of Andrew Edge of the City of Philadelphia in behalf of the Heirs & Descendants of Nathaniel Evans That we would Grant them to take <sup>up</sup> One Hundred & Ninety two Acres of Land the Remainder of five Hundred Acres the Original Purchase of the said Nath: Evans made of the late Propriet: by Deeds of Lease & Release dated the 23<sup>d</sup> & the 24<sup>th</sup> dayes of September Anno Dni 1681 These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd in the aforesaid Right according to the Method of Townships appointed the said Quantity of One Hundred Ninety two Acres of Land that has not been already Survey'd nor appropriated nor is Seated by the Indians & make Returns thereof into the Secretary's Office in Order for a further Confirmation Given under our hands and the lesser Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 8<sup>th</sup> day of 9<sup>th</sup> Anno Dni 1727.*
