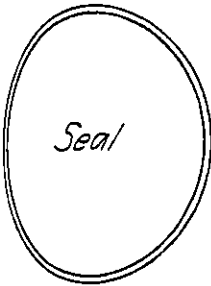

At the Request of Andrew Edge of the City of Philadelphia in behalf of the heirs or Descendants of Nathaniel Evans That we would Grant them to take up the proportion of Liberty Land belonging to five Hundred Acres the Original purchase of the said Nathl Evans made of the late Propriet^r by Deeds of Lease & Release dated the 23^d & 24th dayes of September Anno Dni 1681 These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be Surveyd in the Right aforesaid the said proportion of Land where the same may be found Vacant within the Liberties of Philadelphia and make Returns thereof into the Secretarys office Given under our Hands and the lesser Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 8th day of 9th Anno Dni 1727.
