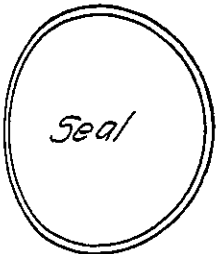

taken up by others We doe also hereby Require thee to execute or cause to be executed
~~the~~ that part of our Warr^t bearing date the 20th day of November in y^e Year 1702
relating to the s^d Jonathan Stammers Purchase without any Delay, and make
Returns thereof into the Secretaries Office Given under our hands & Seal of the s^d
Province at Philad^{ia} the fifteenth day of Octob^r A.D. 1708 - Edw^d Shippert
