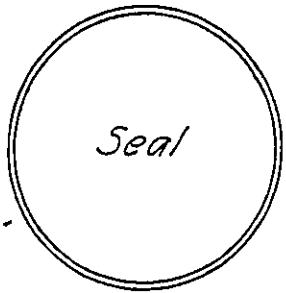

At the Request of William Harmer of the County of Philadelphia That we would grant him a Resurvey on a certain Tract of Land laid out to him in the Manner of Springfield for One hundred Acres & Confirmed to him by Patent from the Prop^{rs} Commission^s bearing date y^e 29th day of y^e 11th Moth 1688 to the end that the Survey & Running of one Line thereof w^{ch} as he complains was left unfinished, may now be completed. These are to Authorize & Require thee to Resurvey or cause to be resurvey'd the said Land so far as is necessary to complete the Survey afores^d And make Returns thereof into the Secretaries Office. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 25th day of the 6th Moth 1709
