By virtue of the Commissioners Warr<sup>t</sup> dated y<sup>e</sup> 30<sup>th</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> mo 1712 for laying out to me two thousand five hundred Acres of Land in right of Matthew Marks's Original Purchase of five thous<sup>d</sup> Acres together with other Land mentioned in the 5<sup>d</sup> Warr<sup>t</sup> I desire thee to return One thousand Acres Surveyd by David Powel<sup>r</sup> <sup>on y<sup>e</sup> French Creek</sup> above those 30 thousand Acres laid out to Matthew Vincent D<sup>r</sup> Cox & Co, Seven hundred thereof to James Pugh & 300 to Simon Meredith to whom I have sold the same. Dated 24<sup>th</sup> 4<sup>th</sup> mo 1713
