



By Vertue of a War^t from Edward Pettington Survey^r Gener^l bearing date the 11:10th m^o: 1700 directed unto me I do hereby Certify into his Office that I have Surveyd and Laid out unto Martha Hatten a Certain^e tract of Land in the County of Philadelphia begining at a stake sett in the ground being a Corner deviding it from James Brooks and Company^s: Land from thenc^e North East by the ^{said} Brooks Line of marked trees 500 perches to a Hickry marked from thenc^e North west by a Line of marked trees 160 perches to a ~~stake~~ ^{stake} ~~sett in the ground~~ deviding it from a tract of Land Laid out for the proprietary and Governor from thenc^e by a Line of marked trees South West 500 perches to a black oke marked from thenc^e South East by a Line of marked trees 160 perches to the plac of begining Containeing and Laid out for five hundred acres of Land Laid out y^e 13th of y^e 11th m^o: Ensuieing
