

Pursuant to a warrant from the Commissioners of Property dated the 20th of the 11th month 1778 for five hundred acres of land to be surveyd to Hance George Schutz & Matthias Ringer. There was surveyd and laid out unto the said Matthias Ringer on the sixth day of the 3^d month 1778 one piece or parcel of land on the west side of the river Schuylkil Beginning at a post by the said River Schuylkill at a corner of Andrew Sucklers land and running by the said land south west three hundred forty ~~forty~~ six perches ~~to a perches~~ to a post then south east eighty-two perches to a post then north east ^{by Martin Urrers land} one hundred fifty-four perches to the side of Schuylkil then up the the Water Courses of the same to the place of Beginning. Contain- ing one hundred and seventy five acres Returned into the Secreta- ry's Office the 19th of the 4th 1778.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this seventeenth day of February 1910.
