Beginning at a corn<sup>t</sup> post standing by the side of a deep Runn by y<sup>e</sup> Schuylkill side being likewise a corn<sup>t</sup> of Peter Dalboes Land ffrom thence following downe y<sup>e</sup> severall water courses of y<sup>e</sup> River Schuylkill to a small Creek or Runn ffrom thence following along y<sup>e</sup> severall courses of y<sup>e</sup> said Creek or Runn to a certin Creek or Runn formerly called Pennis Creek ffrom thence upon a direct course to a certain Mulberry tree marked standing on Mall Smears poynt ffrom thence following up y<sup>e</sup> severall courses of y<sup>e</sup> fast land and Pennis Creek to a corn<sup>t</sup> oak tree standing near the head of y<sup>e</sup> said Creek being a corn<sup>t</sup> tree of y<sup>e</sup> Township of Pasayunch thence east by y<sup>e</sup> said Township 140 p<sup>t</sup>ches to a corn<sup>t</sup> white oak of Peter Dalboes land thence N.W. by y<sup>e</sup> said Land 134 p<sup>t</sup>ches to a corn<sup>t</sup> tree standing by y<sup>e</sup> side of a small Runn ffrom thence following downe y<sup>e</sup> severall courses of y<sup>e</sup> said Runn to y<sup>e</sup> place of beginning containng 353 acres Returned in to y<sup>e</sup> Secretaryes office y<sup>e</sup> 11<sup>th</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> first m<sup>o</sup> 169<sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub>.
