These are to authorize and Require thee forthwith to Survey and lay out to Thomas Callowhill in right of Isaac Martindale Purchaser of one thousand acres the said quantity and full proportion of land upon that vacancy in Southampton Township containing about 479 Acres and that other vacancy of 400 Acres between Southampton & Neshaminy and the remainder upon the next nearest vacancy that is of value; also to survey and lay out in right of Jn^o Blakelins Original Purchase of one thousand Acres in the whole the said quantity and in right of Br^d Snead one thousand Acres, and in right of Jn^o Elson five hundred Acres, ~~at in the most comm~~ & lastly in right of Rich^d Penn five thousand Acres all in the most commodious and valuable vacancies or overplus Land not held or claimed by the owners in whose Land it is found, and particularly to run an exact division Line between the Societies and Mildmay's Lands and the upper lately Survey'd Townships. also to run the Division Line of James Claypooles and such other Tracts as have not their true boundaries ascertained and make Returns into the General Surveyors Office at Philad^{ia} where this warr^t is to remain & a copy thereof to be delvd to thee certified by the Secretary.
