Whereas there is a piece of vacant Ground in the City of Philadelphia situated on the south side of High Street between the seventh and eighth Streets from Delaware - and bounded by a Lot granted by Patent to William Branson on the east and the Lot granted by Patent to Isaac Norris and Charles Norris on the West, containing about twenty-seven feet in Breadth and Front on High Street and in Depth Three hundred and six feet. These are to authorize and require you to survey the said lot of Ground herein before described & make return thereof into the Secretaries Office for our use Given under my Hand and Seal of the Land Office by virtue of certain powers from the said Proprietaries at Philadelphia this twenty-seventh Day of May in the year of Our Lord One thousand seven hundred & sixty-five
