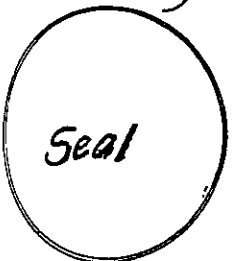

 and to make exact Returns of suc Surveys into the Secretary's Office
 that have by Warrants heretofore issued been appropriated to our Use.
 Lieutenant Governor of the said Prov who in pursuance and by virtue
 to him for this purpose (inter alia) gr ted by the said Proprietaries hath
 the Seal of the Land Office to be ed at Philadelphia this Twenty f
