Copy D^e and lay out to the said John Roberts the s^d several quantities of land amounting to two hundred and fifty acres in one tract where not already surveyd nor taken up nor concealed nor seated by the Indians to be held ~~yearly~~ under the yearly rent of one half penny sterl. ^s acre, and make returns thereof into the General Surveyors Office at Philad^{ia} where this warr^t is to remain and a copy thereof to be deliv^d. to thee certified by the secretary. Given under our hands & y^e seal of y^e Province at Philad^{ia} the 17th of the 6th moth 1702.
