Surveyd and set out for Charles Read Esq. a Piece of Land at Travescan in the County of Philadelphia by him bought of Henry Scofel beginning at a post in a corner—the said Charles Read's other land being also a corner of Evan Ower's land Thence running by the said Read's line South west seventeen perches and a half to another corner of the said Charles Read's land then north twenty five degrees west nineteen perches and a half to a post then north east seventeen perches and a half to a post then south twenty-seven degrees and a half easterly nineteen perches and a half to the beginning the three last lines by the said Henry Scofel's land Containing Two acres.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this thirteenth day of December 1909.
