At the request of Owen Roberts of the City of Philadelphia Gent. that we would grant him to take up in this Province the quantity of five hundred acres of land the remainder five thousand acres purchased of the Propriet^r by George Palmer whose surviving Sons Thomas and William hath granted the said five hundred acres unto the said Owen Roberts by Indentures of Lease & Release dated ye 29th & 30th days of the month called July 1715. These are to authorize and require ^{thee} to survey or cause to be survey'd unto the said Owen Roberts within the said Province according to the method of Townships appointed the said quantity of five hundred acres of land that has not been already survey'd nor appropriated nor is seated by the Indians and make returns thereof into the Secretary's Office in order for a further Confirmation Given under our hands and Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 12th day of Septem^r Anno Din. 1715
