By vertue of a warrant from ye Com^{rs} dated ye first day of Octob^r 1692 directed to ye Survey^r Generall, I do by authority from him certifie into ye Secretaryes office that there was surveyed and laid out ye same day unto Sam^l Nicholas rent^l a lott in ye Towne of Philadelphia contayning in Breadth thirty ffoot and in length one hundred ninty eight ffoot bounded northward with vacant lotts Eastward with back lotts Southward with Richard Cantvills lott and to ye westward ye Third street from Delaw^r which is accordingly entred and recorded in ye Survey^r Generalls office at Philadelphia ye 8th of ye 4th mo. 1693.
