



By ye Comission<sup>r<sup>s</sup></sup> impower'd to grant lotts & lands in ye Province of Pennsilvania & ye Territories thereunto belonging.

At ye request of Cadd<sup>r</sup>. Morgan purchaser of three hundred twelve acres of land yt wee would grant him to take up his lott in ye City proportionable.

These are to will and require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him a lott on Skulkill side in any of ye streets sett out for purchasers of ye like quantity he fencing it in & building upon ye same w<sup>th</sup> in six months from ye date of survey & make returns thereof into ye Secretary's office.

Given at Philadelphia ye 16<sup>th</sup> of ye 7<sup>th</sup> mo. 1684
