



A Draught of a tract of land situate in the Manor of Springtown in the County of Chester now in the possession of James Nesbit beginning at a post in a line of James Moores land thence by the same S. 80° E. 76 paces to a post in the Manor line thence along the same S. 25° E. 12 paces to a post thence by land of James Scott S. 7° W. 104 paces to a Chesnut and S. 21° W. 96 paces to a stone thence by land of Nathan Evans N. 28° W. 178 paces to a marked hickory thence by land of Moses Bean N. 68° E. 30 paces to a stone and N. 23° E. 55 paces to the place of beginning containing ninety two acres and allowance of six paces for Road &c. surveyed the 16th day of October 1753 by direction of the Hon^{ble} the Proprietaries.
