


FORM No. 1.

October ye 20th day 1730.

Surveyed for Roger Kirk of Nottingham in Chester County in the Province of Pennsylvania Weaver a small tract of land being and lying situuate at the North end of a tract of land purchased of James Stapler &c. by the said Roger Kirk being situuate in Nottingham in the County & Province aforesaid begining at a chestnut stake & at the North East corner of the said tract and runing from thence North sixty eight roches yⁿ S 82° W. 141 foches yⁿ South 50 foches yⁿ East 140 foches to the first begining containing fifty one acres of land more or less.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twenty fourth day of March 1910
