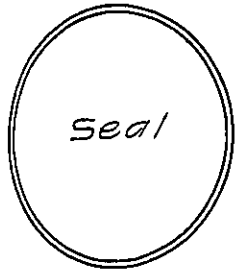

William Penn Proprietary and Govern^r of the Province
of Pennsylvania and Counties annexed.

At the request of my Daughter Leetitia Penn that I would grant
her a resurvey on all the lands in this Province formerly laid out
to her or apprapriated to her use.

These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey or cause to be
resurvey'd the said lands according to their bounds and the
bounds of the lands adjoining and make exact returns thereof
into my Secretaries office.

Given under my hand and Seal at Philadelphia the 3^d
day of Octob^r 1701.
