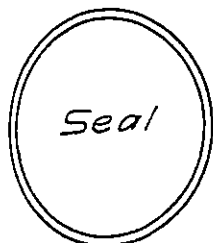


Pennsylvania Ss.

Survey or cause to be survey'd immediately for our use all the vacant land within five miles of Bransons & Nutts Iron Works in Chester County and return the same in our names into the Secretaries office and for so doing this shall be your sufficient Warrant.

Given under my hand and the Seal of our land office by virtue of certain powers from the said Proprietaries at Philadelphia this fourteenth day of September in the year 1742.
