



A Draught of a tract of land situate in Londonderry Township in the County of Chester containing sixty ~~three~~<sup>three</sup> acres and a half and the usual allowance of six acres  $\frac{1}{100}$  for Roads &c. Surveyed to David Kennedy by Warrant of the 29<sup>th</sup> of October 1743 and returned into the Secretary's office the 31<sup>st</sup> day of August 1750
