



By virtue of a Warrant to me directed dated ye 7<sup>th</sup> 1<sup>st</sup> m. 1701 I have survey— unto James Brown a tract of land in Nottingham beginning at a white oak being a corner of Randl Jennys land thence North 560 p<sup>ch</sup> to a corner post thence West 140 p<sup>ch</sup> to a corner hickery being a corner of ye Prop<sup>ty</sup> land thence South 560 p<sup>ch</sup> to a corner hickery thence— Est 140 p<sup>ch</sup> to ye place of beginning containing 490 acres of land the 15<sup>th</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> m. 1702.
