



By virtue of a warrant to me directed dated ye 7<sup>th</sup> 1<sup>st</sup> m. 1701 I have survd unto Cornelius Empson a tract of land in Nottingham begining at a corner black oak being a corner of the Propry land thence North 490 p<sup>ch</sup> to a corne-black oak thence West 160 p<sup>ch</sup> to a corne-black oak being a corner of Will-browns land then S. 490-to a corner black oak thence Est 160 p<sup>ch</sup> to the place of begining containing 490 acres of land the 10--2--m. 1702
