 I have surveyed for ye Prop^y a tract of land in Nottingham
 begining at a corner post being a corner of Ebenezer Empsons
 land thence by his line North 480 ^{perch} to a corner black oak
 from thence West 163 ^{perch} $\frac{1}{3}$ to a corner black oak being a
 corner of Cornelius Empsons land thence South 480 ^{perch} to
 a corner hickery thence Est. 163 $\frac{1}{3}$ perch to the place of be-
 gining containing 490 acres of land the 14th day of the 3rd
 month 1702.
