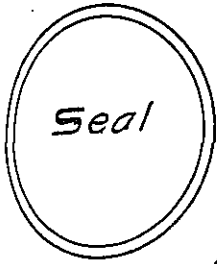


Pensilvia 55.

By the Commissioners of Property.

At the request of Hubert Cassel that we would grant him to take up two hundred <sup>& fifty</sup> acres of land on the West side of Skuykill near that tract w<sup>ch</sup> was seated by Peter Bizailon & for some time possessed by Mathew Brooks for which he agrees to pay forty pounds for the whole in one year after ye date hereof with six month interest for the same and the yearly quitt rent of one shilling sterling ~~of~~ hundred forever. These are to authorize and require thee to survey <sup>Hubert or cause to be surveyed to ye said Hubert Cassel according to the Cassel method of townships the said quantity of two hundred and fifty</sup> <sup>250</sup> acres of vacant land in the place aforesaid and make return thereof into the Secretarys office with which agreement if the said Hubert — shall duly comply this said survey shall be valid otherwise ye same is to be void as if it had never been made nor this Warr<sup>t</sup> ever granted. Given under our Hands and Seal of the Province at Philad<sup>ia</sup> the 15<sup>th</sup> day of ye 12<sup>th</sup> month A. D. 1717/8
