

Pursuant to a Warrant under the hand and seal of the Proprietary and Governour to me directed bearing date the 29th day of the 6th month 1700. I do hereby certify, that I have caused to be surveyed unto Thomas Story Attorney to Joseph Pike in right of Samuel Rowles old Purchaser of five thousand acres a certain Tract of Land situate in the Township of Limerick in the County of Philadelphia beginning at a post by a street or road running through the said Township standing in the line of Jacob Telmer and Company's Land from thence by the said Line of marked trees South West five hundred perches to a black oak marked from thence North West by a Line of marked trees one hundred and sixty perches to a post sett in the ground from thence North East by a Line of marked trees five hundred perches to a post by the said street or road from thence by the same South East one hundred and sixty perches to the place of beginning containing and laid out for five hundred acres of Land. Surveyed the 8th day of the 9th month 1700 and Returned according to the above said Survey and bound into the Proprietary and Governour's Secretary's Office the 17th day of the 10th month 1700.
