At the Request of Thomas Story Attorney for Joseph Pike That We would Grant him to take ^{up} One thousand Acres more above what hath been already taken ^{for and} up _{in} right of his Said Constituent Purchaser of five Thousand Acres under Samuel Rolles Original Purchaser of the sd Quantity from the Proprietary: These are to Authorize and require thee to Survey and lay out for the sd Joseph Pike the said Quantity of One thousand Acres of Land that hath not been already Survey'd nor taken up, nor is concealed nor seated by the Indians in two distinct Tracts and Townships. In the County of Bucks the first Tract to be laid out in the Townships that is now laying, or the first that shall be laid out in ye sd County to contain five hundred Acres. The other to be laid out in the next Township ^{after} that shall be in ye sd County of Bucks and make Returns into the General Surveyors Office at Philad^{ia} where this Warrt is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd to thee certified by ye Secretary.
