At the Request of John Swift That We would grant him to take up eight Acres of Land within the Liberties of the City Philadelphia in right of his own purchase of five hundred Acres and eight Acres more in right of William Bingly's first purchase of the like quantity purchased by the said John: These are to require thee forthwith to Survey and lay out to the said John Swift the said quantity of Sixteen Acres within the said Liberties of Philadelphia where not already Survey'd nor taken up and make Returns into the General Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this Warrant is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delivered thee certified by the Secretary who is also to take a Duplicate of thy Return into his Office. Given under our hands and ye Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 25th of the 12th Month 1701
