

By virtue of a Warrant from the Commiss^t of Property bearing date the 26th day of April 1708 there was survey'd unto James Shattrick in right of Thomas Pierce of Lymrick in the Kingdom of Ireland a tract of land in the County of Philadelphia beginning at a White oak at a corner of John Holland's land thence North East by the same two hundred forty six perches to a post thence North West by vacant land three hundred and twenty ~~perches~~ ^{six} perches to a black oak sappling thence South West two hundred and forty ^{six} perches to a post thence South East by John Welch his land three hundred and twenty ~~perches~~ ^{six} perches to the place of the beginning containing _____
