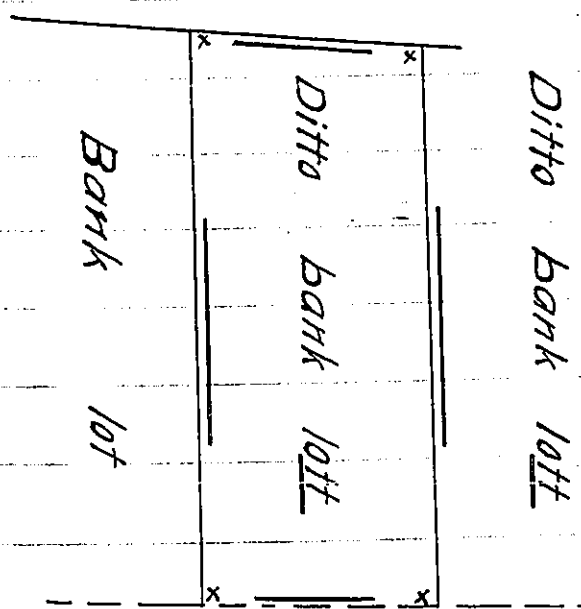
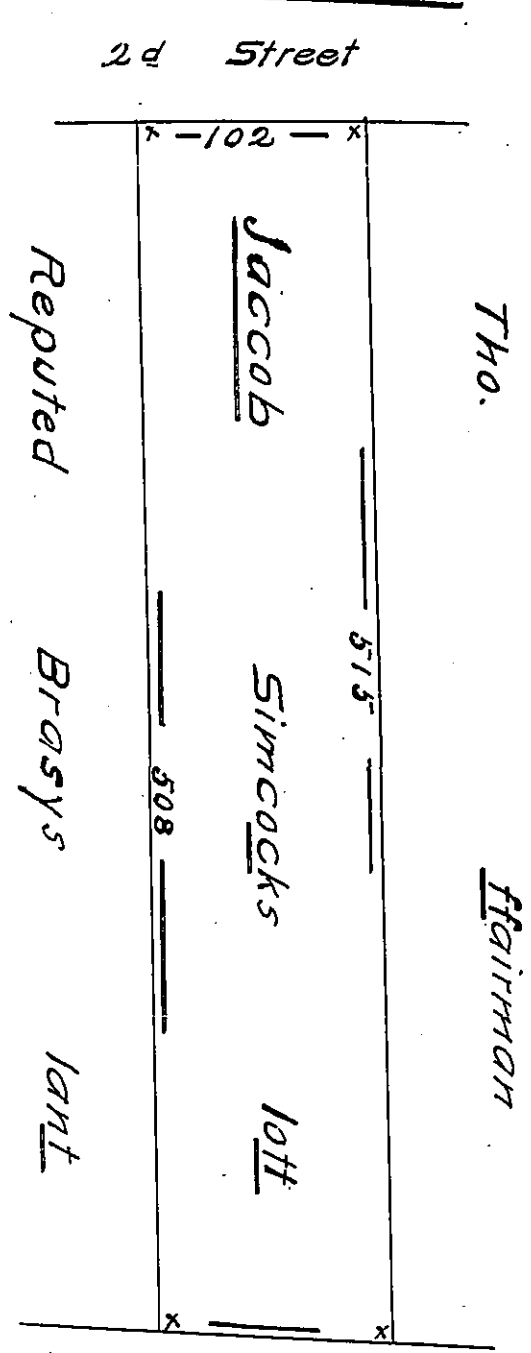

Pursuant to a Warr from ye Comis<sup>rs</sup> of Prop-ty directd unto me beareing date ye 14-2<sup>mo</sup>. 1703 I do certiefy yt I have reasurveyd unto Jaccob Simcok a lott in ye Citty of Philladelphia bounded one ye East with Delaware frunt street and one North with Thomas ffairmans lott in right of Thomas Rudyard and one ye West with ye 2d street from Delaware and one ye South with Brasys reputed lott being in lenth one ye North sid 515 feet and one ye South sid 508 feet and in breadth 102 foot with ye bank frunteing ye said lott being in breadth 102 foot and in lenth 250 foot bounded one East with ye said river one ye North with sd ffairmans bank lott and one ye West with said frunt street and one ye South with reputed vaccant bank lott together with a High street lott bounded one ye East with Benjamin ffurlas lott and one ye North with bak lotts and one ye West with a vaccant lott and one ye South with ye said High street scituat between ye 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> street from Delaware resurveyd ye 21-4<sup>mo</sup>. 1703 and according to the bounds above described as hearby returnd into ye Generall Survey<sup>rs</sup> Offic at Philladelphia ye same day
