an^{nt} purchaser of five hundred acres yt I would grant him part
& a lott in ye City
of ye same in ye County of Philadelphia.

These are to will & require thee forthwith to survey or cause to
be survey'd unto him three hundred acres in ye Welch Town-
ship, two hundred & fifty of ye sd purchase & fifty James Marti-
more's headright & a lott in ye City proportionable to ye purchase
& make returns thereof into my Secretary's office.

Given at Philadelphia ye 24th of 1683.
