Whereas Nicholas Skull being desirous to purchase a tract of land in the Manor of Springfield adjoining on the land he now holds in the said Manor and running from the South West corner thereof by Thomas ffitzwaters line to ~~the~~ Daniel Howels northeast corner containing by estimation two hundred acres or thereabout for which he hath agreed to pay for the use of the Proprietary forty pounds for every hundred acres and so proportionally one moiety of the whole at or before the 29th of 7^{br} next with lawful interest for the same to the said time and the other moiety at or before the 25th of the first month next ensuing.

These therefore are to require thee forthwith to survey and lay out to the said Nicholas Skull the said tract of land scituate as aforesaid and make returne thereof into the General Surveyors office at Philadelphia where this Warrant is to remain and a copy thereof to be delivered to thee certified by the Secretary being so made and returned shall in case the said Nicholas — fulfil the agreement aforesaid be valid otherwise shall be void and of no other effect than as if the same same had never been made nor this warrant ever granted.
