

Pursuant to a warrant under the hand and seal of the Proprietary and Governour to me directed bearing date the 3^d day of the 5th month 1700.

I do hereby certify that I have caused to be surveyed unto Susanna Reading late Osmond now the Wife of Robert Reading in right of her Father Bernard Osmond deceased a certain tract of land scituate in the County of Philadelphia beginning at a stake sett in the ground in the Line of Edward Farmer and Company's land from thence by the said line of marked trees South West two hundred thirty and eight perches to a stake sett in the ground by a hickery marked from thence North West by a line of marked trees by the land known by the name of George Keith's land three hundred thirty six perches and a quarter from thence North East by a line of marked trees two hundred thirty and eight perches from thence South East three hundred thirty six perches and a quarter to the place of beginning containing and laid out for five hundred acres of land Surveyed the 15th day of the ninth month 1700 and returned according to the abovesaid survey and bounds into the Proprietary and Governour's Secretary's office the 5th day of the 10th month 1700.
