


By virtue of a warrant bearing date ye 31<sup>st</sup> day of ye 3<sup>rd</sup> mo. in ye year 1703. There was

Resurveyd the 23<sup>d</sup> day of the 12<sup>th</sup> month 1705 unto Evan Owen a tract of land in the Township of Merion in the County of Philadelphia beginning at a post at a corner of James Thomas land from thence South seventy three degrees west forty six perches to a post thence by the land of Thomas Howel North 26 deg<sup>r</sup> west 88 perches to a post thence North 71 deg<sup>r</sup> east 224 ~~perches~~ <sup>perches</sup> to a white oak thence South 40 deg<sup>r</sup> <sup>East</sup> by the land of John Roberts one hundred perches to a Poplar tree thence by the land of Thomas Jones & Company & by Robert ~~Jones~~ Robert's land South 21 degrees East 238 perches to a Chestnut tree thence by Edward Reece's land west South west 188 perches to a Black oak then by the lands of Mary Haverd and James Thomas North north west 254 per<sup>ch</sup> to the beginning containing four hundred fifty acres.
