



William Penn Proprietary & Govern^r of ye Province of Pennsylvania & ye Territories thereunto belonging.

At ye request of Nicholas Moore President yt I would grant him to take up his lotts in ye City of Philadelphia.

These are to will & require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be surveyd unto him on ye River Delaware one front lott & two lotts ~~to~~ backward & also on Skulkill a front lott & two lotts ~~to~~ backward, in breath answerable to his purchase he fencing ym in clearing ye same & building upon ye front lotts and make returns thereof into my Secretary's office.

Given at Philadelphia ye 25th 5th mo. 1684
